

ALL STAR TEAM / BOWLER OF THE YEAR FORMAT - MEN

GUIDELINE RULES

Note: Youth bowlers in Adult leagues will not be eligible to make the Adult All Star Team and/or the Adult Bowler of Year regardless of points accumulated throughout the year.

1. All information from sanctioned Tournament results, Averages, High Series, High Games must be on file at the Local Association Office. Include a copy of individual bowler record/history sheet, if possible.
2. Bowler is responsible for reporting positions in sanctioned Tournaments outside the Local Association to which points can be awarded.
- 3.a) **Minimum** number of games per winter league average for the following will be: 2/3 of league schedule for—*All Star Team* and *Bowler Of The Year* in one bowling centre.
- b) Summer league averages do not apply in any division.
4. There will be 2 Divisions—Men and Senior Men. Senior Division age to be 55 years and older as of August 1st in the current season.
5. All changes in format shall be at the discretion of the Windsor-Essex Chatham-Kent Bowling Association Board of Directors.
6. Awards will be presented at the Annual Awards Banquet.

ALL LEAGUE AVERAGES / SCORES – JUNE 1ST to MAY 31ST – MUST BE FROM WINDSOR-ESSEX CHATHAM-KENT BOWLING ASSOCIATION AND SANCTIONED C.T.F.

AVERAGES

1. To qualify for points toward the All Star Team and Bowler of the Year the **minimum** average will be 210 for Men and 190 for Senior Men. See Guideline Rule #3 for eligible average to be used.
2. Only **one** league average (highest) from each centre can be used—**maximum** three different centres for the All Star Team and Bowler of the Year.
3. A bowler will receive **1 point** for the minimum average plus 1 point for each increment over the minimum average (e.g.—217 men’s avg. receives 18 points).

INDIVIDUAL SCORES

1. No restriction for the number of games per winter and summer leagues & centres.
2. Points for additional series and games to be the same as the first series and game in each centre.
3. Scores from eligible local sanctioned tournaments, within our jurisdiction, will count. It is the bowlers responsibility to report them to the Local Association Office (include copy of recap sheet or Tournament Directors verification).

TOURNAMENTS

1. Points for placement in the following tournaments handicap & scratch divisions, (restricted tournaments ineligible):
 - a) Ontario Provincial--Annual & Senior 1st = 5 2nd = 4 3rd = 3 4th = 2 5th = 1
 - b) WECKBA Annual Championship 1st = 5 2nd = 4 3rd = 3 4th = 2 5th = 1
 - c) Sanctioned CTF within WECKBA 1st = 5 2nd = 4 3rd = 3 4th = 2 5th = 1
2. Participation Points awarded in the following tournaments (restricted tournaments ineligible):
 - a) Ontario Provincial--Annual & Senior – per event (limit 4, subject to format) 1 point
 - b) WECKBA Annual Championship – per event (limit 4, subject to format)) 1 point
 - c) Sanctioned CTF within WECKBA – per entry (limit 2) 1 point

ALL STAR TEAMS

The All Star Teams will be the top 4 point earners for each division—Senior Men and Men (one team only in each division).

Note: Seniors have the option to declare which division they are entering when submitting form/s.

BOWLERS OF THE YEAR

The bowler who has accumulated the highest number of points for each division (Senior Men and Men) during the season (June 1st to May 31st) will be the Bowler of the Year in their Division.
