ALL STAR TEAM / BOWLER OF THE YEAR FORMAT - WOMEN

GUIDELINE RULES

- <u>Note</u>: Youth bowlers in Adult leagues will <u>not</u> be eligible to make the Adult All Star Team and/or the Adult Bowler of Year regardless of points accumulated throughout the year.
- 1. All information from sanctioned Tournament results, Averages, High Series, High Games must be on file at the Local Association Office. Include a copy of individual bowler record/history sheet, if possible.
- 2. Bowler is responsible for reporting positions in sanctioned Tournaments outside the Local Association to which points can be awarded.
- 3.a) **Minimum** number of games per <u>winter</u> league average for the following will be: *All Star Team* and *Bowler Of The Year* $-\frac{2/3}{2}$ of league schedule in <u>one</u> bowling centre.
 - b) Summer league averages <u>do not</u> apply in any division.
- 4. There will be 2 Divisions—Women and Senior Women. Senior Division age to be 55 years and older as of August 1st in the current season.
- 5. All changes in format shall be at the discretion of the Windsor Essex Chatham-Kent Bowling Association Board of Directors.
- 6. Awards will be presented at the Annual Awards Banquet.

ALL LEAGUE AVERAGES / SCORES – JUNE 1ST to MAY 31ST – MUST BE FROM WINDSOR ESSEX CHATHAM-KENT BOWLING ASSOCIATION AND C.T.F. SANCTIONED

AVERAGES

- 1. To qualify for points toward the All Star Team and Bowler of the Year the **minimum** average will be <u>180</u> for <u>Women and160 for Senior Women</u>. See Guideline Rule #3 for eligible average to be used.
- 2. **Maximum** number of leagues allowed for averages will be <u>three</u> (3). If more than three, then the 3 highest averages will count. For All Star Team and Bowler of the Year one average must be from a different centre (cannot use 3 averages from same centre).
- 3. A bowler will receive **1 point** for the minimum average <u>plus</u> 1 point for each increment over the minimum average (e.g.—198 women's avg. receives 19 points).

INDIVIDUAL SCORES

- 1. No restriction for the number of games per winter and summer leagues & centres.
- 2. Points for additional series and games to be the same as the first series and game in each centre.
- Scores from eligible local tournaments, within our jurisdiction, will count. It is the <u>bowlers responsibility</u> to report them to the Local Association Office (include copy of recap sheet <u>or</u> Tournament Directors verification).

ALL STAR TEAMS

The All Star Teams will be the top 4 point earners for each division—Senior Women and Women (one team only in each division).

BOWLERS OF THE YEAR

The bowler who has accumulated the highest number of points for each division (Senior Women and Women) during the season (June 1st to May 31st) will be the Bowler of the Year in their Division.
