**'SCRATCH' AND 'PINS OVER' DIVISIONS FOR BANTAM - PREP - JUNIOR - SENIOR
BANTAM DIVISION IS SPONSORED BY CLUB 240 AND WINDSOR CHORISTERS**

\$25.00 (bowling \$9.89, expenses \$1.00, scholarship fund \$14.11)

This Singles Tournament is open to all youth members of the Windsor Essex Chatham Kent Bowling Association in good standing, actively bowling in WECKBA youth leagues, and is sanctioned through the Canadian Tenpin Federation. Bowler's age as of August 1, 2025 to be used - Bantam (8 and under), Prep (9-11), Junior (12-14) and Senior (15-21). All 'scholarship funds' will be returned 100%. Bowlers may only bowl once.

Bowlers will bowl three games on the same pair of lanes. Their 'Pins Over' score will determine the top four qualifiers in the 'Pins Over' Division.

Immediately following the last shift, match play will be held in the 'Pins Over' Division. All qualifiers must report in person to their designated lanes. The four highest qualifiers in all divisions, boys and girls, will bowl match play to determine the winners' positions (4th place will bowl 3rd place; the winner of that match will bowl the 2nd place qualifier, and the winner of that match will bowl the high qualifier). All winners will receive a scholarship.

There will be no qualifying in the Scratch Division -- 1st and 2nd place finishers, both boys and girls, will receive scholarships.

A bowler is automatically entered in both Scratch and Pins Over Divisions and may win scholarships in both.

A minimum of \$4800 will be allotted for scholarship funds - in the Pins Over Division, 1st place will be \$200, \$100 for 2nd place, \$75 for 3rd place, and \$50 for 4th Place. In the Scratch Division, 1st place will be \$100, 2nd place will be \$75. Scholarship funds are managed by the Youth Committee of the WECKBA.

The scholarship money will be held for the winners and will be payable to the learning institute of their choice at an accredited university or college, trade schools, business schools, or adult learning classes to further their education. Under no circumstances will the bowlers be given scholarship money.

The scholarship funds must be used before the bowler's 25th birthday. Any funds not used by that time will revert to the general scholarship fund.

The entry form must be submitted to the Scholarship Tournament Director, along with the entry fee, no later than October 28, 2025. Refunds will not be returned after that date.

Bowlers will use their highest final 2024-2025 season Yearbook average - minimum 21 games or their highest current league average - minimum 12 games - as of October 28, 2025 whichever is higher. All other bowlers not meeting these criteria will bowl scratch.

In the event of any tie, a one game roll-off will decide the winner.

CTF tournament rules and regulations shall govern. Substitutes or replacement bowlers are not allowed.

Any protests must be submitted to the Scholarship Tournament Director in writing within 72 hours of participation.

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
